Meetings are due in Pre-School in June. Please make an appointment with the staff.

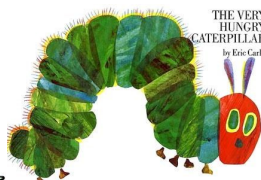


Monday, 30th May is a Bank Holiday. The Nursery will be closed.
