- Shakespeare's 400th anniversary of his death (23rd April);

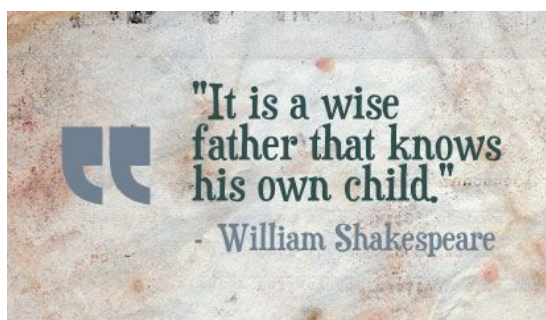


Our front and back gardens have been refurbished with new synthetic grass, and the children and staff have been having a great time on them.

GET PINK'D!

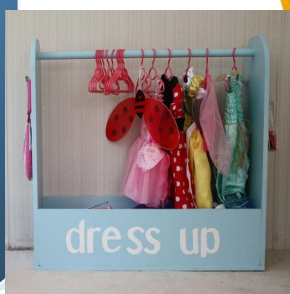

We would appreciate if you could donate any old books with props or any outfits for dressing up.

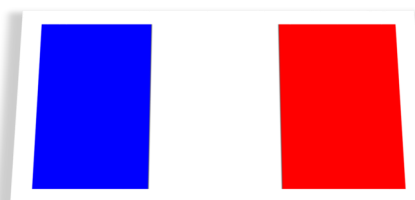


Topic of the Month:
