NOTE: Nursery rhymes and finger plays must be used throughout the year to enhance the curriculum. Children must be introduced to both fiction and non-fiction books for all subjects. Poems and rhyme are an important part of learning vocabulary and memorization skills. Stories should be read aloud and allow time for the children to 'read' aloud to their peers. Show and tell should be once a week

Circle time must include oral recognition and review weekly:

- Numbers 1-10 + counting 1-20 & skip counting in 3rd term
- Phonics a-z + ch and sh sounds
- A-Z letters
- All basic colors
- All basic shapes
- Days of the week
- Months of the year
