On another note:

Labelling Items: Please can you ensure your child's jumpers/coats/hats/scarfs are labelled clearly.

Harvest Collection: From the week beginning Monday 23rd September, we will be collecting for the Harvest Festival at nursery. We welcome all children to donate a tin or dried non-perishable items to our collection. On Friday 27th September, preschool children will be taking them to the church. *The top 5 items needed are:*

- Long Life Milk
- Tinned meat and fish
- Tinned Soup
- Tinned fruit and Veg
- Jams and Spreads
- Rice puddings and custard

Parking: Please park your car in front of the church and walk round to the nursery. Only staff are able to park at the back of the church. This is for the safety of all children and families.

Spare Clothes: Please make sure your Child has a bag of spare clothes on their peg at nursery. Otherwise, we will have to phone you to collect your Child early should they need changing.

Water Bottles: All Children MUST have their own water bottles clearly labelled for nursery and their own lunch bag for snacks and lunch. Please put your child's name on these items!

Winter Weather: Please ensure your Child has a warm coat for nursery as we like to go out in all weathers. If you have any problems managing this or need support, please speak to Nadine or Joanna. We will be most happy to provide your Child with warm clothing. Our team will always make every effort to travel in, however there are times when it is unsafe for staff and children. You will receive a text message by 7am if the nursery will not be opening.

Christmas Party: The last day for all Children is Friday 13th December 2024. The children are welcome from 8am in their own clothes, to enjoy a festive party. There will be games, party food provided by the nursery and a special visit from Santa! Parents are welcome back from 11am to collect their children. The nursery will close for Christmas break and reopen on Monday 6th January 2025.

Monthly Nursery fees: Please ensure you pay your nursery fees on time. Fees are due on the 1^{st} of each month.
