Uniform

The Orchard has red sweatshirts, polo shirts and sun hats available to buy if you would like uniform for your child. Big Club

Big Club is a session on a Tuesday afternoon that is aimed specifically at children in the year before they start primary school, and is an excellent way to help them prepare for the transition. The staff plan a variety of activities that enable the children to develop their number and letter skills, as well as their independence, such as putting on shoes and coats by themselves. They are also encouraged to practise some of the less obvious skills required at primary school, such as working together in a cooperative manner. The children who have been to Big Club have experienced very positive transitions to primary school and we are very grateful to Monika and the team for making such a successful programme.
