Dear Parents/Carers

As all the parents have been informed, unfortunately, because of a confirmed case of COVID-19 in the nursery, all the staff and children now have to self-isolate for 14 days. We know that you may find this concerning, but we are continuing to monitor the situation and are working closely with the government guidelines.

To clarify the situation, the children will need to self-isolate until Friday 11th December and can return to nursery on Monday 14th December.

If your child shows any one of the symptoms of Coronavirus during this time, you must get them tested. All the information you need is in the letter I sent out yesterday evening. Please note that siblings do not need to self-isolate unless they are showing any of the symptoms and can attend school as normal at this time.

COVID-19 Please note the following important points

- If your child is not attending nursery for any reason, you must inform the school on the first day of absence before 9:00 am with the reason for absence and how long they are likely to be off. Not all absences are going to be COVID-19 related but we need to know why pupils are off on any particular day.

- If your child shows any one of the symptoms of Coronavirus

a high temperature

a new and continuous cough

loss of taste and smell

you need to get them tested straight away. If the result of the test is positive, they need to stay at home for ten days from the day they were tested. If the result is negative, they can return to school.

- If your child has come into contact with someone who has tested positive i.e., a family member, the child needs to self-isolate for 14 days from the day that they carried out the test. If they show no symptoms during this period they can return to school after 14 days. If they show symptoms at any point during this self-isolation, they need to get a test and if this is positive, they will need to begin the ten days of isolation from the day of the test.

If you have had your child tested, please share the results with us before they return to the nursery.

Anyone with symptoms will be eligible for testing and this can be arranged via
